Contemporary painter Ali Golkar was born in the ancient city of Isfahan, Iran in 1948. Growing up in a city rich in history and abundant artistic influence, Golkar became infatuated with the arts at a very young age.

The obvious sophistication of Golkar's unique aesthetic process combines elements of the 20th century Expressionism, Cubism and Abstraction. Yet it is Golkar's unique synthesis of a *mélange* of influences that has earned him status as one of today's most charismatic, cotemporary painters.
