Judith Rothchild was born in Boston, Massachusetts in 1950 and studied at Sarah Lawrence College before entering and completing her artistic degree at the Rhode Island School of Design. In 1974 she moved to Europe to continue her training at the Academy of Applied Arts, in Vienna. Since 1974 she has been living in a small village in the Languedoc region of France. It was here that she decided to devote herself to pastels and etching.

Judith Rothchild has held over 30 solo exhibitions of her work throughout the United States, France, Switzerland, England and Spain. She produces screen prints in her own atelier and since 1996 has been working in mezzotint, producing individual prints, as well as livres d'artiste, which have been acquired by various public collections throughout France and the United States.
